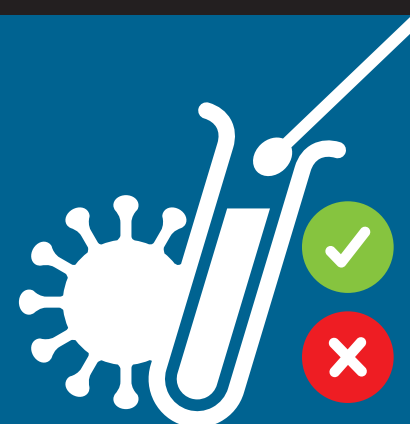


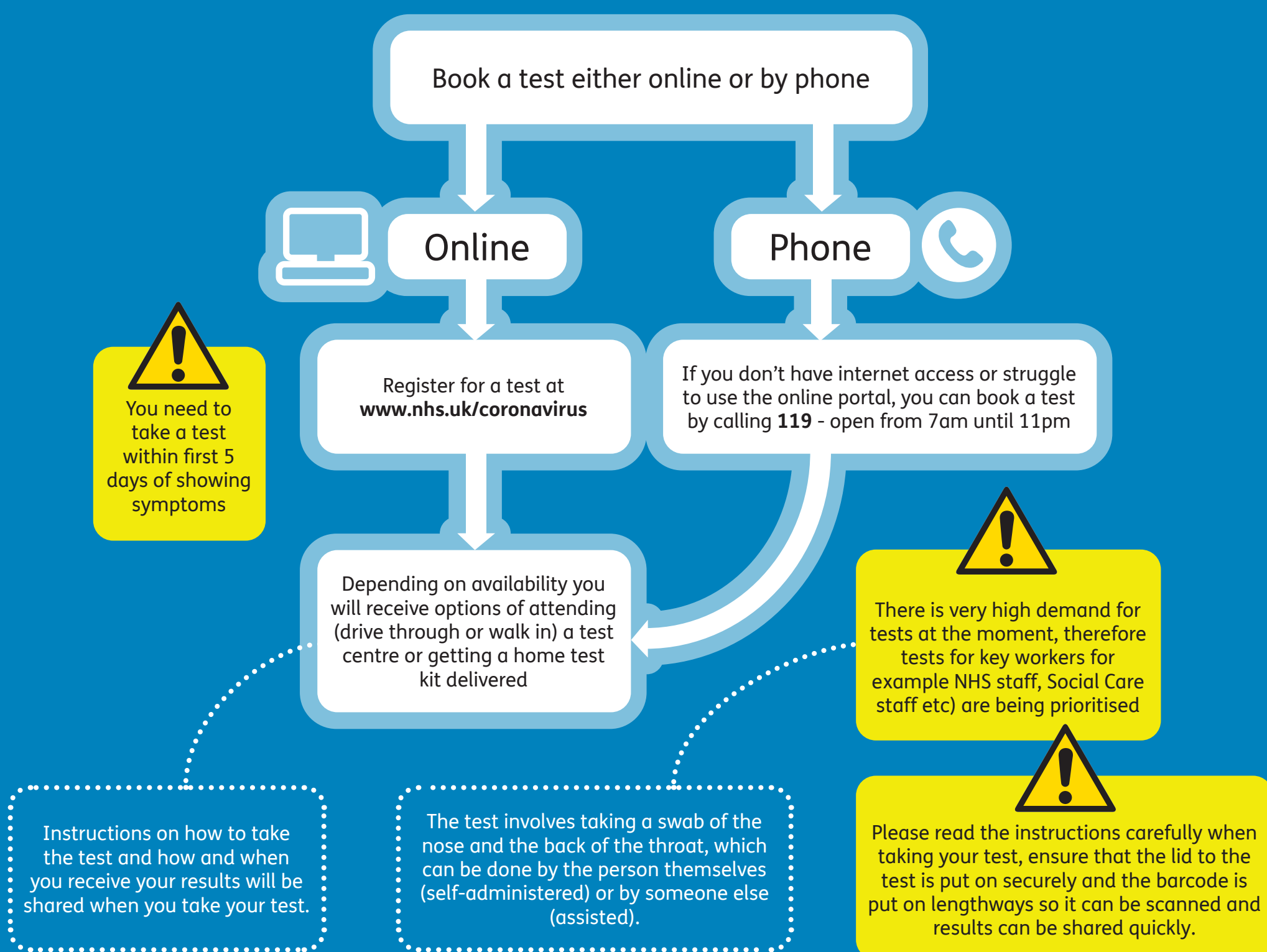
General Public - How you can access a Coronavirus test (excluding Key Workers)



Everyone who is showing coronavirus symptoms is eligible to book a swab test to find out if they have the virus.

You can ask for a test:

- For yourself, if you have coronavirus symptoms now (a high temperature, a new, continuous cough, or a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste).
- For someone you live with, if they have coronavirus symptoms.
- The test is not suitable for children under 5.
- If you're asking for a test for someone else and this person is aged 13 or over, check they're happy for you to ask for a test for them, before booking.



NOTE: There is another type of test (antibody test) that checks if you've already had the virus. This test is not available yet.
